



Pace of Play

Wednesday Golf & Weekend Events

We have compiled a comprehensive review of our current Pace of Play for Wednesday Golf & Weekend Events and determined that our Pace of Play should improve for the overall well being of all Members.

We have implemented a Pace of Play Policy to help reduce our playing time & to match the Edinburgh USA 'Time Par' of 4 hours and 9 minutes.

This policy is practiced with the intent of maintaining a reasonable pace of play for ALL Members.

Please help us stop slow play.

A group will be considered 'out of position' when they are 10 minutes behind pace (19 minutes behind the group in from of them). The SAC Director & a representative from the SAC Board will be reviewing the Edinburgh USA Tee Sheet logs every Thursday & following Weekend Events. We recommend that you check with the Player's Assistants at the starter shack when you make the turn at 9 & finish your round at 18 to ensure an accurate report of your Pace of Play BEFORE you turn in your scorecard.

The following infractions are in place and will be assessed individually:

- First Infraction: We will notify the players in that specific tee time that they were out of position and issue a verbal warning
- Second Infraction: Letter from the Board.
- Third & Subsequent Infractions: A 2-stroke penalty will be added to the individual's score for the event.

To file an appeal, contact the SAC Board and a group of 3 or more Members will convene to review the appeal and promptly contact you.

All Members should take responsibility to ensure every player in the group is keeping pace with the group ahead. Remember to play ready golf.
